## About St. Claire Regional

St. Claire Regional Medical Center (SCR) opened its doors on July 1, 1963 as a general acute care hospital with 41 beds, nine nurses and six physicians representing three specialties (General Practice, Surgery and Internal Medicine).

Today, SCR serves as a 159-bed regional referral center. The Medical Center is the largest rural hospital in northeastern Kentucky and has a service region that includes a population of over 160,000. The SCR Medical Staff is comprised of over 100 physicians, representing more than 30 medical specialties. SCR is a Catholic, not-for-profit hospital sponsored by the Sisters of Notre Dame in Covington, KY. Additionally, SCR is the second-largest employer in the region, with nearly 1,400 employees.

In addition to providing services at the Medical Center's main campus in Morehead; SCR's operations include:

SCR also partners with UK Healthcare to offer services at the Morehead Cancer Treatment Center.

The Medical Center is an established training site for the UK School of Medicine's Rural Physician Leadership Program.

## ABOUT MOREHEAD

Morehead is located in Rowan County, Kentucky, situated on I-64 in the foothills of the Appalachian Mountains and nestled in the heart of the Daniel Boone National Forest.

Morehead serves as the economic, educational, recreational and cultural hub of the region. The town is home to both a top-ranked university and a comprehensive community and technical college. A combination of local and chain restaurants offer a variety of dining options. Plus, numerous arts and music festivals, including the Cave Run Storytelling Festival, draw visitors throughout the year.

The area features a low cost of living,

low real-estate taxes and a variety of housing opportunities. In addition to established neighborhoods and new housing developments, farmland and rural housing options are available.

## ROWAN COUNTY SCHOOLS

Rowan County schools include four elementary schools (PreK-5), one middle school (grades 6-8), and one high school (grades 9-12). Gifted/talented education needs are met in a variety of ways including specialized grouping, enrichment within the regular classroom and advanced placement courses. Also, the middle and high school speech teams are often top teams in Kentucky.

Private schooling opportunities are also available through three private, parochial

schools: Lakeside Christian Academy, Rowan Christian Academy and Farmers Christian Academy.

## MOREHEAD STATE UNIVERSITY

Morehead State University has been recognized for 7 consecutive years as one of the top public universities in the South. The University offers nearly 80 degree programs on the two-year, four-year and graduate levels.

The University has an enrollment of over 9,500 students representing 106 Kentucky counties, 42 states and 35 foreign countries. Two-thirds of the faculty hold doctoral degrees and the student/faculty ratio is 17 to 1.

## CAVE RUN LAKE

Beautiful Cave Run Lake, an 8,300-acre recreational lake located within minutes of Morehead in the Daniel Boone National Forest, hosts some of the best muskie fishing in the United States.

The lake has two campgrounds with nearly 400 campsites for both RV and tent camping. Twelve boat ramps are located on the lake and hiking trails provide miles of exploration. Enthusiasts return time and time again to this exciting yet relaxing environment offering fun-filled adventures to those of all ages.
