PGY 1 (10 days): Cardiology, Surgery, Critical Care

PGY 3 (15 days): Electives greater than 2 weeks (unless choosing Outpatient Family Medicine as elective), Pulmonology/Podiatry, Palliative/Pain and Urology/GI

Nursing Home Scheduling:

Residents are scheduled to attend Nursing Home sessions during the following rotations:

PGY 1 – 7 sessions: Outpatient Family Medicine (x2), Cardiology, Surgery, Newborn Nursery, Critical Care, Emergency Medicine

PGY 2 – 8 sessions: Outpatient Family Medicine (x2), Sports Medicine, Emergency Medicine, Gynecology, Orthopedics, Outpatient Pediatrics & Electives

PGY 3 – 9 sessions: Outpatient Family Medicine (x2), Palliative/Pain, Outpatient Pediatrics, Podiatry, GI/Urology & Electives
